In order to register for Kindergarten your child needs a current 680.

1. The completed series of DTP/DTaP (Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Acellular Pertussis).
2. The 2-dose MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella).
3. The completed series of Polio Vaccine.
4. The 2-dose Varicella (Chickenpox).
5. The 3-dose Hepatitis B series.

These shots are available (**at no charge**) at the Florida Department of Health Bay County or at your private physician's office. Please bring a copy of your child's current immunization record.

After your child has been immunized, please return the completed immunization 680 form to your child's school so that your child may start school on the first day.
