To enroll in FLVS courses, go to www.flvs.net. In the upper right corner, click on MENU.




After you open up the Menu, click on County Virtual Schools.



Scroll to the bottom of the page and complete Step 1, Browse the course catalog.



If you are a new student to Bay Virtual School, you should meet with a guidance counselor before choosing courses. Returning juniors and seniors need to call to set up an appointment with a guidance counselor to complete a credit check to make sure the student is on track for graduation. Students that are transitioning from elementary to middle school, or middle school to high school also need to set an appointment with the guidance counselor to review new course provider options. It is recommended that all students set up a phone or face to face conference with a guidance counselor at least once per year. Course progression plans are located on the <a href="Bay Virtual School website">Bay Virtual School website</a>, under RESOURCES and at the bottom of the page under FORMS.




Returning students **should use their current FLVS student login** information. New students click on "New Students Start Here."



Click on, "I live in Florida."



Choose "Bay" as the County. Then choose "Public/Charter School Student." Click continue.



Click on the Education Level. In this example we are choosing regular classes for a high school student. Next, click on the first subject area. We are starting with English as the subject and English 1 as the course.



Here you will see a detailed description of the course. Choose all segments. This allows the student to register for this English 1, Semester A and Semester B at the same time. However, you will only take one semester at a time. Check the box that states you have the prerequisite courses.




Be sure to choose "Bay Virtual School" to be considered as a Bay District School student with local teachers, administration, and support. Then click "Continue."






The name of the course, course code, number of segments (semesters), and credits earned upon completion is listed at the top of the page. You may then select the reasons for taking this course. Our BVS students may check "Online format preferred."

Click, "Yes, this is on my class schedule." Then choose, "Teacher or School Counselor." You may leave the Referral Code blank. Click "Continue."






You can now see that English 1 is added to your backpack as a Bay Virtual School student. You may now add more courses, or click "Continue" to set up your account. New students should select "Continue."
